

WATER CLARIFICATION SYSTEMS

Clarification consists in removing all kind of particles, sediments, oil, natural organic matter and color from the water to make it clear. A clarification step is the first part of conventional treatment for waste and surface water treatment.

It usually consists in:

- Screening
- Physical chemical treatment is a generic term for Coagulation-Flocculation
- Sedimentation or Flotation, upon particles properties and water type.
- Lamella settler
- Coagulant dosing station.
